

FAQ's

What is the date of the game?

- The Canada vs Romania game is on Saturday June 17th 2017.

What time is Kick Off?

- Kick off is **tentatively** set for 3:00 PM

Where is the game?

- The game is at Ellerslie Rugby Park located at 11004 9 Avenue Southwest, Edmonton, AB

Where do we park?

- Parking is located at Ellerslie Rugby Park, enter through the North East back gate off of 5th Ave SW. **There is no entrance through the main ERP gates.** Please do not park in adjacent business parking as attendants will be out and cars may be towed. Parking is \$20 per car.

What can I bring in the park?

- You can bring a small personal bag with items pertinent to an outdoor viewing activity. Items may include, blanket, hat, sunscreen, umbrella, camera, extra clothes.

What **can't** I bring to the park?

- Alcoholic beverages, bottles, cans
- Food products (sealed water bottles are permitted)
- Weapons
- Laser Pointers
- Pressurized air-horns, and any other items illegal or deemed to be a risk
- **No Pets (Service Animals are permitted)**
- Persons possessing any of these items may be denied entry or subject to removal
- **All bags are subject to search prior to entering the park**
- Prohibited items are subject to change

What else is going on Saturday June 17th?

- We will have a Kids camp, tailgate party, curtain raiser and much more.

What's up with the kid's camp?

- The kids camp will take place at Ellerslie Rugby Park from 8:00 am- 10:00 am on Saturday June 17th. Full details, registration information and camp outline will be released in the next four weeks.

Tailgate party at a rugby game?

- Yes!!!! Open at 10:00 am you will be able to enjoy local eats, beats and beverages. Family friendly with lots of action and entertainment leading up to the big game. Space is limited and entry is included with early bird tickets until March 31st.

Curtain Raiser? What's That?

- A curtain raiser is a game played before the main event. Our curtain raiser is a game between Men's Under 20 Canada vs Under 20 USA at 12:00 p.m.

What's the best seat?

- There is a price point for every budget and all seats have great views of the field. The closer you sit to the middle of the pitch is typically a better view point.

Do you have accessible seating?

- Yes. Located in Zone #3 there is accessible seating. Select accessible seating from the ticket chart.

VIP Options?

- Yes, we have many different options for VIP's that include some hospitality.

What comes with a VIP Suite?

- A private tent on a 4' riser along the east side of the field. Simply the best viewing and hosting experience. Includes tickets for 15 people, 15 tailgate passes, a designated VIP host, a bison roast meal, VIP souvenir credential, private VIP bathroom trailer, furnished engineered 10 x 10 tent, post game VIP party tickets and game day swag. You can purchase up to another 10 tickets to bring the total to 25 people in each suite. The earlier you buy the closer to mid field your VIP suite will be.

What's the VIP Pit?

- The VIP Pit is an 18 and older area located at the North West corner of the field. Unobstructed views of the entire pitch make this an ideal location for you and some friends to have an unbelievable time. Tables and chairs as well as risers will enhance your viewing experience. Included in your pit pass is 10 beverages, VIP souvenir credential, tailgate passes, dedicated food and beverage services and washrooms.

What's the difference between the VIP zone #1 and VIP Pit?

- VIP zone #1 gets all the benefits and access of the VIP Pit but also includes a bleacher seat in the West stands on the 50m line. Located behind the stands will be a dedicated VIP Food and beverage stand to avoid line ups during game play.
